OFFICIAL NEWS**President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov conducted an online working session**

On May 10, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov held an online working session with the participation of some Deputy Chairmen of the Cabinet of Ministers, khyakims of velayats and Ashgabat city to give consideration to the issues of socioeconomic development of velayats, implementation progress of the seasonal agri-works, and preparation to the upcoming festive events.

First, via the digital communication channel the leader of nation came into contact with Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers Sh. Durdylyev (who is in charge of the capital) and the khyakim of Ashgabat Ya. Gylyjov.

Khyakim of the capital's administration has reported on the situation in the main city of the country, preparation progress to the festivities on the occasion of 30th anniversary of the country's sacred independence and 140th anniversary of Ashgabat, construction rates of the objects to be commissioned on the jubilee dates.

Khyakim has also informed that on the initiative of khyakimlik and social organizations of the capital, the ecological action started in Ashgabat on the occasion of the 140th anniversary of the capital. In the frames of the action, in the period throughout May 10-25, the city's traffic will be tied up except for the public transport facilities, taxis and specialized transport vehicles.

Vice-Premier Sh. Durdylyev has reported on the situation at the construction sites of the objects to be opened in the capital and regions in honor of the remarkable dates.

In comments on the report, the leader of nation Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has placed accent on ensuring high quality and timely execution of construction works at the anniversary and other objects. In this regard, the relevant presidential instructions were given to the Vice-Premier.

Having studied the designs of the Ashgabat-city projects, the head of state made some remarks and corrections.

Then, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov got connected with Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers E. Orazgeldiyev (in charge of the AIC) and khyakims of velayats.

The implementation progress of the current agri-works, construction rates of the jubilee objects, and preparation to the upcoming festivities were the issues the reports of khyakims of velayats were centered on.

President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has exhorted khyakims to organize the work in velayats in tune with the times, having fixated particular attention on the trouble-free functioning of all life support systems.

Along with daily agri-works, not the least important is to keep the preparatory work going to the grain harvesting time, prepare for service grain combines and grain collection stations, in order this important agricultural campaign was accomplished in well-organized way and in due time.

The relevant assignments, which were concerned with the improvement of the land fertility, rational water use, and widespread adoption of the advanced agri-technologies, the leader of nation has addressed to khyakims of velayats.

Having noted that in the total output of agri-production special attention is to be paid to further increasing of production volumes of vegetable and cucurbitaceous crops, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has ordered to better manage and attend the fields planted to spring potato, onion and cucurbitaceous crops. The relevant presidential instructions were also addressed to the country's silkworm breeders related to cocoon production and fulfillment of their contractual obligations.

President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has also ordered to hold under control the situation at the facilities built in the territories of velayats. The works are to be carried out in strict compliance with the schedule established and with the use of eco-friendly materials.

Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers E. Orazgeldiyev has reported on the situation in the agricultural fields of the country.

Special attention in the report was concentrated on the measures taken for improvement of water supply in the country and rational use of water resources in the AIC. The report covered also the work of the existing hydro-facilities and construction of new ones.

To cope with the tasks set and ensure trouble-free water supply to the arable lands, the leader of nation has pointed to the necessity of timely cleaning of the canals, exercising control over keeping the hydro-facilities and pump stations in good working condition.

Further, addressing the participants of session, the leader of nation has focused on the necessity of activating the work on formation of ecological culture in the country. In this regard, the head of Turkmenistan has noted the importance of conducting the ecological action with the use of such healthy transport as bicycle.

Finishing the online working session, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov wished strong health and success in work to its participants.

The leader of nation took part in the cycle race in the frames of the ecological action

On May 11, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov took part in the ecological action, having given a start to the cycle race

timed to the 140th anniversary of the capital of independent neutral Turkmenistan.

In the morning, the head of state accompanied by Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers Sh. Durdylyev, who is in charge of the capital, proceeded to the southern part of Ashgabat to start the cycle race. The race route ran across the most beautiful streets of the country's main city.

En route, the Vice-Premier has informed the head of state about the situation in Ashgabat, in particular about the measures undertaken for provision of ecological wealth in the capital, organized preparation to the celebration of the 140th anniversary of the city, as well as about fulfillment of the earlier presidential assignments on acceleration of construction of the jubilee objects.

The leader of nation has focused on the necessity to keep close eye on the ecology improvement and tree-planting actions in the city, maintenance in the appropriate condition the parks and public gardens.

Deputy Chairmen of the Cabinet of Ministers, the Mejlis Speaker, heads of military and law enforcement agencies have joined the race at the intersection next to the Monument of Neutrality.

Further, deputies of the Mejlis and members of the Halk Maslakhaty of Milli Gengesh, heads of ministries and sectoral departments, social organizations and mass media have joined the action.

Along the whole length of the race, new participants, including students, representatives of public, younger generation, were joining the ecological and sport action. Children of the "Döwletliler köşgi" Palace have also joined the cycle race with enthusiasm.

Led by the head of state Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov, the column of participants of the cycle race continued their way along the streets of the city.

During the ride, the head of state has focused on the tasks of further improvement to social and living conditions of the people in tune with the requirements of the times.

It is necessary to provide every possibility for active involvement of the population, especially the youths, into physical-culture and sport actions, the leader of nation noted.

Finishing the cycle race, the President of Turkmenistan headed to the Main Square of the country. Having covered the distance of the race with the skills of experienced racer, the head of state has again demonstrated the importance of physical training and sports for physical health and spiritual improvement of people.

From the Square, the participants of the cycle race proceeded to the "Ashgabat" Monument to welcome the success of the action organized on the occasion of the 140th anniversary of the capital.

The President of Turkmenistan received the head of the State Oil Company of Azerbaijan

On May 12, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov received the head of the State Oil Company of the Republic of Azerbaijan (SOCAR) Rovnag Abdullayev, who arrived in Ashgabat to participate in the International Forum on attracting foreign investments to the oil/gas complex of Turkmenistan.

During the meeting, it was noted that Turkmenistan had taken workable steps to develop its richest hydrocarbon deposits, diversify energy supplies from the Caspian region to the world markets.

In this regard, the parties discussed the possibilities of enhancing partnership in the strategic fuel-and-energy sector, including in the implementation of joint projects, the most important of which is the development of hydrocarbon resources of the largest "Dostluk" field in the Caspian Sea.

It was noted that the Memorandum of Understanding signed on January 21 of the running year between the Government of Turkmenistan and the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan on joint prospecting, exploration and development of hydrocarbon resources of the within-named field opens up new prospects for joint work on a solid international-legal basis, providing favorable conditions for large foreign investments, strengthening of national economies, creating new jobs, improving the level and quality of life of the population.

The President of Turkmenistan and his guest have stated that the Caspian theme is the most important area of cooperation between Turkmenistan and Azerbaijan – the countries, which make significant contribution to the transformation of the Caspian Sea into the zone of peace, good neighborliness and efficient partnership.

Phone talks between the President of Turkmenistan and the Prime Minister of Japan

On May 13, President of Turkmenistan Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov had a telephone conversation with Prime Minister of Japan Yoshihide Suga.

At the beginning of conversation, the head of the Japanese Government has extended his deepest condolences to the Turkmen leader on the occasion of his father's demise – Myalikguly Berdymuhamedov, whose selfless work and services to the Turkmen state would remain imbedded forever in good memory.

During the conversation, the parties have discussed the current state and prospects for the development of interstate partnership, as well as a number of international policy issues of mutual interest.

Welcoming the productive cooperation between Turkmenistan and Japan in the bilateral and international formats, the interlocutors have confirmed their willingness to the intensification of the dialogue.

President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov and the head of the Japanese Government were unanimous in the opinion that activation of the trade-economic ties is one of the priority directions of the Turkmen-Japanese partnership. The oil/gas sector, energy, transport and communications, as well as such areas as water resources management and the textile industry were reckoned among the strategic areas of cooperation.

The interlocutors have also expressed themselves in favor of enhancement of scientific-educational contacts.

In continuation of the phone talks, the President of Turkmenistan has informed that construction of the gas-turbine power plant in the Lebap velayat with the participation of the Japanese company "Sumitomo Corporation" is now at the completion phase. The Turkmen leader has invited the Prime Minister of Japan Yoshihide Suga to visit Turkmenistan in the third decade of August to take part in the ceremony of commissioning of the new gas-turbine power plant. The Turkmen leader expressed confidence that this visit would open up new opportunities for deepening the bilateral cooperation and promote enhancement of the interest-based partnership.

Phone talks between the President of Turkmenistan and the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan

On May 13, President of Turkmenistan Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov had a telephone conversation with President of the Republic of Kazakhstan Kassym-Jomart Tokayev.

Warmly greeting each other, the heads of the neighboring states have exchanged congratulations on the occasion of completion of the month sacred for all Muslims and on the coming of Oaza Bayramy.

In the course of the talk, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov and President Kassym-Jomart Tokayev were pleased to note the strategic and constructive nature of the interstate dialogue built on the principles of mutual respect, trust, and openness.

At present, Turkmenistan and the Republic of Kazakhstan cooperate successfully practically in all spheres of the bilateral partnership, including in the political, trade-economic, humanitarian-cultural spheres, where there is an impressive untapped potential for the future long-term fruitful interaction.

The two countries' leaders expressed confidence that the traditionally friendly Turkmen-Kazakh

relations would continue to become deeper and develop dynamically in the spirit of good-neighborliness and mutuality-based cooperation for the public good.

Phone talks between the President of Turkmenistan and the President of the Kyrgyz Republic

On May 13, President of Turkmenistan Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov had a telephone conversation with President of the Kyrgyz Republic Sadyr Japarov.

After an exchange of pleasantries, the leaders of two countries have extended congratulations to each other on the occasion of Oaza Bairamy and addressed wishes of wealth and prosperity to the Turkmen and Kyrgyz nations.

The head of Kyrgyzstan has extended his deepest condolences to the Turkmen leader on the occasion of his irretrievable loss – the demise of his father Myalikguly Berdymuhamedov, and conveyed words of deep empathy and support on behalf of the Kyrgyz people.

Continuing the phone conversation, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has congratulated his colleague on the success of referendum and adoption of new Constitution, having highlighted that the Main Law would serve as a solid foundation of Kyrgyzstan's further development and promote successful implementation of major reforms aimed at improvement of the Kyrgyz people's wellbeing.

The head of Turkmenistan has noted that in the last years, our countries have managed to enter on a qualitatively new level of interaction in many directions, especially in the political, trade-economic, cultural-humanitarian spheres.

During the conversation, the leaders of Turkmenistan and the Kyrgyz Republic have discussed the priority directions of bilateral interaction, having made special mention of the importance of activating the productive contacts between business circles of the two countries.

Not the least important is expansion of partnership in the humanitarian sphere, in particular, in motivating the scientific-educational ties and cultural dialog, Presidents Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov and Sadyr Japarov have highlighted.

The sides have also shared opinions on the current issues of regional and international problems, which are of reciprocal interest.

Phone talks between the President of Turkmenistan and the President of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan

On May 13, President of Turkmenistan Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov had a telephone

conversation with President of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan Mohammad Ashraf Ghani.

Taking advantage of the opportunity, Presidents Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov and Mohammad Ashraf Ghani have exchanged congratulations on the occasion of the holy Oraza Bairamy sacred for all Muslims and addressed wishes of peace and prosperity to the peoples of Turkmenistan and Afghanistan.

Welcoming the by-now productive character of partnership in the trade-economic, fuel-energy, transport-communication spheres, the parties have emphasized that at present, with the participation of the two countries, large-scale joint projects are carried out in these areas. The corollary of it is construction of the Turkmenistan-Afghanistan-Pakistan-India (TAPI) transnational gas pipeline and the Turkmenistan-Afghanistan-Pakistan high-voltage power transmission and fiber-optic communications lines.

Special emphasis was paid to the importance of the “Lapis Lazuli” transit-transport corridor, created within the framework of the Agreement signed between Turkmenistan, Afghanistan, Azerbaijan, Georgia, and Turkey. In this context, Presidents Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov and Mohammad Ashraf Ghani expressed confidence that the successful implementation of this project would significantly contribute to the development of interregional trade-economic relations.

On behalf of the Afghan people, President Mohammad Ashraf Ghani has expressed deep gratitude to the Turkmen leader for fraternal solidarity and active support in the stable development of the neighboring state, for the economic and humanitarian assistance.

Off-site sessions of the Cabinet of Ministers of Turkmenistan and the Emergency Commission for Disease Control

On May 14, on arrival to Balkan velayat on a working tour, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov held an off-site session of the Cabinet of Ministers in the “Avaza” National Tourist Zone, as well as took part in the off-site session of the Emergency Commission for Disease Control.

Opening the session of the Government, the leader of nation gave the floor to Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers G. Mushshikov who reported on the measures taken to ensure sustainable development of all sectors of the national economy and velayats of the country, as well as on the efficient use of public funds.

Preparation of the State Budget for 2022 in the light of the Program of the President of Turkmenistan for the country’s socioeconomic development in 2019-2025 was a separate topic of the report. Together with the main financial plan, it

is planned to develop the projects of the Guidelines of Socioeconomic Development and Investment program of the country.

Commenting on the report, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has focused on the importance of detailed elaboration of all items of the State Budget. Particular attention is to be given to the increased funding of the social sphere, including the development of education and health systems, and wages and salaries.

The head of Turkmenistan has also noted the necessity to analyze by the Ministry of Finance and Economy in association with each ministry, sectoral department, khyakimliks of velayats and Ashgabat city the volumes of funds to be allocated by the State Budget.

Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers Sh. Abdrahmanov has reported on the construction progress of the third oil-loading terminal at the Kenar Oil Storage and Shipping Terminal of the Turkmenbashy Refinery Complex.

Having listened to the report, the President of Turkmenistan has stated that in compliance with the “Program of Turkmenistan’s oil/gas industry development until 2030” construction is projected of a number of new technological units at the Turkmenbashy Refinery Complex. In this regard, primary attention is to be paid to the increase of crude oil supply to the Complex, timely shipping of the output produced by the region’s largest refinery enterprise to the local and foreign consumers.

Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers E. Orazgeldiyev has reported on keeping the work going for strengthening of the foodstuff sector and efficient preparing for the wheat-harvesting campaign.

Summing up the report, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has exhorted to improve the AIC management policy, adopt the efficient financial-economic mechanisms to motivate the work of tenants and farmers.

While signing the Resolution “On measures for ensuring well-organized conducting of wheat harvesting in Turkmenistan in 2021”, the President of Turkmenistan has addressed the relevant instructions to the officials concerned on efficient tackling of the tasks enshrined in the Resolution.

Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers Sh. Durdulyev has reported on fulfillment of the earlier presidential assignments and on the preparedness rate to the coming events on the occasion of the 140th anniversary of Ashgabat.

In view of the importance of the coming remarkable date, the head of state has ordered to create every condition for holding the festive measures at a higher and better level in terms of organization and content.

Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers B. Ovezov has reported on construction progress of the complex of residential buildings intended for

the personnel of transport-communication sphere in the town of Turkmenbashi, Balkan velayat.

In the comments on the report, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has highlighted that construction of residential estates together with social facilities and modern infrastructure is an important requirement in realization of the development-favored urban and rural construction projects.

Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers Ch. Gylyjov has reported on the work carried out by the Ministry of Education for procurement of computers, as well as on measures taken for maintaining exporters of local production.

Prior to presenting the learning computers to the first-grade school students on behalf of the President of Turkmenistan, the tests of “Bilimi” computers and the relevant confirmative documents have proved that technical specifications of computers meet the quality and safety standards for children’s health.

Having focused on the importance of developing special multimedia learning aids for the personal computers to provide high visualization of the entire course of study of the first-grade school students, the head of state signed the “Türkmenistanyň Bilim ministrliginiň kompýuterleri satyn almagy hakynda” Resolution and gave certain instructions for solution of the tasks enshrined in the document.

Deputy Chairperson of the Cabinet of Ministers M. Mammedova has reported on preparation of holiday events dedicated to Constitution and State Flag Day of Turkmenistan.

Focusing on the importance of this deep-patriotic holiday, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has highlighted that the events countrywide celebrated on the occasion of Constitution and State Flag Day of Turkmenistan are the embodiment of humanity, friendliness and hospitality inherent to our nation.

Further, the floor was given to Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers M. Geldinyiazov who presented for consideration of the head of state the proposal on drafting of the Resolution on approval of the National Program of the immunity improvement of the population of Turkmenistan in 2021-2025 and the Action Plan for realization of the Program.

The main goal and tasks of this National Program are the protection of the population’s health, creation of the foundations for sustainable economic development of the country, achievement of high social level of the people, strengthening and increasing of the national gene pool.

Summing up the report, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has highlighted absolute importance of the by-now preventive measures, development and spread of the information-education materials among the population,

implementation of the awareness-raising and advocacy activity on a regular basis.

Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers Minister of Foreign Affairs R. Meredov has reported on the results of the working visit to the town of Xian, the People’s Republic of China. In the frames of the visit authorized by President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov, the delegation of Turkmenistan took part in the meeting of the foreign ministers in the “Central Asia – China” format.

Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers, the State Security Council Secretary Ch. Amanov has reported on the situation in the structures answerable to him and fulfillment of the earlier presidential assignments. The report covered also the preparatory work carried out by the military and law enforcement agencies for celebrating the 140th anniversary of Ashgabat and 30th anniversary of the Motherland’s independence.

Commenting on the report, the leader of nation Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has concentrated attention on the preparation of the measures on the occasion of the 140th anniversary of the main city of the country and 30th anniversary on Turkmenistan’s independence. The holiday events and military parade are to be held at a higher and better level in terms of organization and content, the head of state stressed.

Practice of regular contacts, including at the governmental and departmental levels, is an important factor in the dynamic development of the productive bilateral partnership.

In this regard, the head of state gave a number of certain instructions to the Vice-Premier, Chairman of the Supreme Control Chamber S. Berdymuhamedov.

The Speaker of Mejlis of Milli Gnegesh G. Mammedova has informed about the progress of modernizing the country’s legislative base and about instituting of the anniversary medal in honor of the 30th anniversary of Turkmenistan’s independence.

President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has noted an exclusive importance of work for further improvement of legal foundations of the

state, strengthening of its civil institutions, and democratic values.

Deputy Chairman of the Halk Maslahaty of Milli Gengesh K. Babayev has informed on the measures taken for organizing Halk Maslahaty activity at an appropriate level, as well as on the works ongoing for preparation to festive events on the occasion of remarkable dates of the national calendar.

In the comments on the report, the head of state has fixated attention on the significance of festive events in the life of the country, having highlighted that all of them are to be held at a high organizational level.

At the off-site session of the Cabinet of Ministers, consideration was also given to other important issues of the state life, and the relevant Resolutions were adopted.

Then, in the “Avaza” National Tourist Zone (NTZ), the off-site session of the Emergency Commission for Disease Control was held with the participation of President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov.

Leaders of the State Migration Service of Turkmenistan, the Interior Ministry, transport structures of the country, Ministry of Health and Medical Industry, khyakims of velayats made reports on organization of the summer holiday season, including in the coast of the Caspian Sea, measures undertaken to counteract the negative impact of various infectious diseases.

It was informed that in compliance with developed schedule of summer holidays in the NTZ “Avaza”, the measures are undertaken for organization of additional flights. In the international airports, all the arriving and outgoing passengers are regularly checked by the personnel of the Ministry of Health and Medical Industry. The departure and arrival lounges of all airports are also provided with the protective equipment and devices.

Special passenger trains Ashgabat-Turkmenbashi-Ashgabat will be arranged from June 1 of the running year. New bus routes inside Avaza and intercity bus routes are planned to be opened.

Before going on holidays to the regions and the capital, the citizens (holders of the holiday vouchers) will be vaccinated against COVID-19 in special health centers. All necessary diagnostic and consumable materials are available in the sufficient amount, and the reserve of these materials has been made. In addition, the two units of Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) have been delivered to the country in the frames of the appropriate plan. These units will be installed in the laboratory of Sanitary and Epidemiological Service in Turkmenbashi.

The citizens over 18, who are going on holidays, will receive the document certifying the

COVID-19 vaccination and medical examination within the next 72 hours, as well as absence of the coronavirus infection. The citizens younger than 18 will also receive the document on medical test and examination they've undergone for the last three days.

As of now, the service personnel of Avaza have been vaccinated. They will work in the shift mode – every 15 days and in each shift they will have to be tested for COVID-19.

3 types of vaccine from the Russian Federation and 2 vaccine types from the PRC have been delivered to the country due to the initiative of the head of state.

The temperature of all people coming to “Avaza” NTZ will be measured in the airport, railway station and bus station of Turkmenbashi in the summer holiday season.

All hotels, cottages and recreation centers of NTZ “Avaza” are equipped with the isolation wards and detention centers supplied with necessary medicines and assigned for the patients on suspicion of acute infection. They will be served by the experienced physicians.

To render urgent services, a twenty-four-hour first-aid station.

Disinfections, disinsection and disinfestation works are regularly conducted at the facilities and their neighborhoods. In canteens and cafes, strict control is exercised over organization of public catering system, quality, safety and storage condition of food products.

The issues of ecological, sanitary and epidemiological condition of the water of the Caspian Sea, desalination units and other facilities, as well as in the places of swimming and leisure of the people will be under permanent control. The samples of water, soil and air will be taken and tested in certain points of the Turkmen coast of the Caspian Sea.

The sanatoriums of the country are fully prepared to the summer holiday season. To rehabilitate health in any of the health-improving centers, a citizen is obliged to present a sanatorium extract from the domiciliary health center and health certificate. The permit for coming and staying in “Avaza” sanatorium for rehabilitation of health is given to the citizens on the basis of an additional certificate about COVID-19 vaccination.

Special commission, which exercises control over all work performed, is established for preparation of children's health-improving centers.

Addressing the participants of the session, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has noted that the national health system is being improved and upgraded in tune with the State Program “Saglyk”, and the activity for infectious disease prevention, diagnostics and therapy is modernized on the systemic basis.

The channel of practice exchange with other countries works in the stationary mode. Turkmenistan is in close interaction with the United Nations Organization, its specialized agencies, and the World Health Organizations.

From the first days of detection of acute pneumonia, the Government of the country has demonstrated a responsible and well-thought approach to prevention of the dangerous infection: the activity of ministries and sectoral departments, especially medical facilities, were promptly reoriented to combating the new threat, the leader of nation continued.

Given the global format of the disease spread and its worldwide negative impact on the usual rhythm of life, the Emergency Commission for Disease Control was established, which conducted its sessions twice a week. At the sessions, the important decisions were taken, which result in implementation of the integrated measures for acute pneumonia prevention.

Having noted that healthcare facilities are provided with all necessary medical equipment, personal security facilities, disinfection materials and test-systems for strengthening of measures for prevention of the dangerous disease, the President of the country has highlighted that the round-the-clock service teams made up of the personnel and specialists of border, migration, medical and agricultural services are organized at the border checkpoints.

Strict control is exercised over the quality and safety of food production, which is exported to the country.

The decision of lifting certain restrictions, which have been introduced previously, has been made, the President of Turkmenistan has highlighted, focusing attention of the heads of some departments on the task of priority assigned to them.

Addressing the Minister of Health and Medical Industry N. Amanepesov, the head of state has ordered to determine the site of location in Avaza of the Control Center, which will be chaired by the Minister himself, and approve the Center's composition and its Deputy Chairman. The assignment was also given to develop the action plan for provision of the citizens' safety and submit it for approval.

The departmental hotels and cottages located in the NTZ "Avaza" are to give the reserved vouchers to the holidaymakers in Avaza, the Turkmen leader highlighted.

Optimum organization of the citizens' holidays in "Avaza" NTZ in the summer period, implementation of the explanatory and awareness-raising work among the population are among the main tasks of the Control Center.

Pending the subject, the leader of nation Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has highlighted

the importance of organizing the 24-hour work of desalination units and their safeguarding in the intensified security mode.

The head of Turkmenistan has also focused on the necessity of daily sending by the departmental hotels via the digital system the lists of the citizens with the reserved vouchers to the Control Center and the State Migration Service bodies. To timely accommodate the citizens (holders of the reserved vouchers) in hotels, it is necessary to have a possibility to online verify the relevant information on the web-sites, the leader of nation said.

The information collected in the Control Center is to be redirected to the Main Control Center under the Ministry of Health and Medical Industry, President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov has highlighted, having focused on the necessity of conducting regular works for keeping cleanness of the holiday places.

The Turkmen leader has exhorted Chairman of the State Migration Service B. Ovezov to appoint a responsible person who, together with representatives of other authorized bodies, would be on duty at the checkpoint of "Avaza" NTZ. The instructions have also been given on examining (in the frames of the authorities of control checkpoints) of documents of the citizens arriving for work and holidays, establishment of regular control over registration of the citizens coming from Ashgabat and velayats.

The Interior Minister M. Chakyevev was exhorted, while issuing the temporary permits to the citizens arriving from velayats and working at the objects of the NTZ, to demand to present the official registration certificates issued by the relevant bodies of the State Migration Service.

Among other main instructions are: organization of the 24-hour duty of the Traffic Control police service and the public safety service at the control checkpoints at the entrance to the tourist zone; provision of the request-stops of transport vehicles only in the specially designated places.

To maintain the public order and law, traffic safety, it is necessary to efficiently use the video surveillance system, the leader of nation said.

Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers Sh. Durdylyev was entrusted with the task to ensure uninterrupted energy supply to the facilities located in Avaza.

Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers E. Orazgeldiyev was exhorted to organize constant monitoring of the ecological condition of the coast of "Avaza" NTZ and the Caspian Sea.

A number of concrete assignments were addressed to Deputy Chairperson of the Cabinet of Ministers M. Mammedova on performing the contract-based work by the tourist enterprises located in Ashgabat and velayats with the hotels in Avaza, on informing via the mass media about the types of services provided.

In addition, the officials concerned were given the assignments on arranging (as required) of Internet-services and optic-fiber communication services in the tourist zone, on equipping the Control Center with communication and internet facilities, as well as on organizing in the trade center “Avaza” of qualitative services and control over observance in local hotels of standards of trade, public catering, and servicing.

During the session of the Emergency Commission for Disease Control, Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers, Foreign Minister R. Meredov was assigned to inform the diplomatic missions and consulates of foreign states accredited to our country about the requirements enshrined in the temporary Procedure of organizing the summer holiday season in the “Avaza” National Tourist Zone.

Focusing on the importance of taking sanitary and disinfection measures in the Avaza neighborhoods, the leader of nation has demanded to organize proper functioning in the holiday season of the medical aid points in the recreation facilities, duty-mode work of ambulance services and experienced medical personnel, as well as to provide necessary amount of pharmaceutical and medical materials, and well-arranged work of pharmacies.

It is necessary to exercise strict control over the sanitary condition of the places intended for swimming in the Sea and recreation, the President of the country noted.

Of no less importance is to provide daily submission of the electronic List of the COVID-19 vaccinated citizens to the Control Center, the relevant authorities of the Interior Ministry, and the State Migration Service; to systematically monitor and control the epidemiological situation in the country, the head of Turkmenistan stressed, having wished success in tackling the tasks in this direction.

Having evinced interest in the state of affairs at the construction sites of the country, the President of Turkmenistan gave the floor to the Minister of Construction and Architecture R. Gandymov who reported on keeping works going at the various social, cultural and production facilities.

The President of the country has also got acquainted with the implementation progress of works on revamping and development of the “Avaza” NTZ in the course of his helicopter round of the coastal resort zone located at the environmentally clean Caspian coast, which has turned into the recreation center of international class. Besides, the leader of nation has examined the construction progress of the new industrial and transport-communications complexes erected in the Caspian coast.

On completion of the flight, the leader of nation gave to the officials concerned a number of

concrete instructions on the development-favored directions of the NTZ “Avaza” and the coastal zone on the whole. Then President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov headed to the Turkmenbashi International Airport to depart for the capital.

ORDERS AND RESOLUTIONS REVIEW

• In pursuance of the presidential Resolution, as of January 1, 2022, the customs duties are cancelled on the goods not included into the lists of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th attachments to the Resolution of the President of Turkmenistan No. 9925, July 27, 2008 “On approval of the Lists of goods exempted from customs duties, which are subject to the payment rules of customs duties when importing the goods into Turkmenistan and exporting them outside its borders, and on the volume of customs duties”, on the goods moved out of the territory of Turkmenistan, except for the hand luggage of individuals - private entrepreneurs and individuals engaged in entrepreneurial activities without formation of a legal person, approved in the 2 parts from 100 of the customs cost of such goods.

In accordance with the document, the contracts for export of goods and products manufactured by legal entities not related to the state-owned and private entrepreneurs – individuals, engaged in the entrepreneurial activities without forming a legal entity, as well as for export of goods (raw materials) purchased from the population, according to the exporter’s choice, can be made with or without participation in the commodities exchange trades.

The Ministry of Finance and Economy, the State Customs Service, the State Commodities and Raw Materials Exchange were instructed, together with the Adalat Ministry, in one-month time space to prepare and submit to the Cabinet of Ministers the proposals on amendments and additions to the legislation of Turkmenistan ensuing from the within-named Resolution.

• President of Turkmenistan signed the Resolution on authorizing the Ministry of Education in association with the Joint Venture “Agzybirlik tilsimaty” to make a contract for purchasing and maintaining of 161,739 computers produced in Turkmenistan, and for their installation by August 25, 2021 in the educational institutions.

• The President of Turkmenistan signed the Resolution on establishing of the State Commission for Organized Conducting of the Grain-Harvesting Campaign-2021 and on approval of its composition. The Commission is in charge of ensuring high level and loss-free harvesting of the grain yield, its trouble-free transporting to the warehouses and grain elevators, and of timely implementing of settlements with the grain producers.

• The President of Turkmenistan signed the Resolution on establishing of the Management Center for appropriate organizing of the summer holiday season in the “Avaza” National Tourist Zone. The resolution approved also the Center’s structure.

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

Turkmenistan and China are unleashing the untapped potential of strategic partnership

On May 10, in the town of Xian (the People’s Republic of China), Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers of Turkmenistan, Foreign Minister R. Meredov and Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers, Chairman of the Supreme Control Chamber of Turkmenistan Serdar Berdymuhamedov had a meeting with a member of the PRC State Council, Foreign Minister Wang Yi.

During the talks, the sides discussed the main aspects of the international and regional agenda, as well as a number of matters of mutual interest, including provision of the international information and biological security. Besides, particular accent was placed on the situation in Afghanistan and on rendering by Turkmenistan of the assistance in rehabilitation of the neighboring country’s economy.

The sides have exchanged opinions on the development of cooperation in the transport, communications, trade and other spheres, as well as on progressive enhancement of the cultural-humanitarian dialogue.

The bilateral meetings of the Turkmen delegation with representatives of the relevant ministries and departments of the PRC have also taken place.

On May 11, a meeting was held of co-Chairmen of the Intergovernmental Turkmen-Chinese Committee for cooperation – Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers of Turkmenistan, Chairman of the Supreme Control Chamber S. Berdymuhamedov and Vice-Premier of the PRC State Council Han Zheng.

The sides discussed the current condition and future development of the Turkmen-Chinese cooperation. Special focus has been made on the trade and economic cooperation.

It was noted that being a big trade partner of Turkmenistan, China intends to comprehensively promote the development of relations between the two countries and maintain close relations at a high level.

As of today, cooperation in the gas sphere is a key direction of the two countries’ partnership; at the same time, the sides expressed themselves in favor of development of the interest-based partnership in the transport, telecommunications, digital technologies, financial and banking systems.

The Turkmen side has also proposed to consider the possibilities of advancing cooperation in small businesses by activating the bilateral mechanism for establishing of direct contacts between the commercial and state structures of our countries.

In the light of positive practice of interaction in the health and medicine sphere, the sides have agreed to enhance relations in that direction.

The sides have spoken for activating the work of the Intergovernmental Turkmen-Chinese Committee for cooperation in the priority directions of trade-economic cooperation and making advantageous conditions for closer partnership between the two countries.

The second meeting of the foreign ministers in the “Central Asia-China” format was held on May 12. Authorized by President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov, the delegation of Turkmenistan took part in the meeting.

In his welcoming speech, the member of State Council, Foreign Minister of the PRC Wang Yi has highlighted the importance of intensification of cooperation between the two countries’ foreign departments for implementation of the agreements reached at a high level and for promotion of the multi-faceted partnership between the countries.

During the talks, the ministers exchanged opinions on enhancement of the trade-economic, investment, cultural-humanitarian relations. Combating pandemic and intensification of interaction in the medical, healthcare and scientific directions were also in the center of discussions.

The sides have also considered the current problems of international and regional agenda, having highlighted the importance of deepening foreign-policy coordination in safeguarding security, stability and sustainable development.

In the course of meeting, it was noted that the all-round consolidation of peace, regional stability, provision of conditions for safe and sustainable development of our friendly states and nations are the aspects Turkmenistan regards as key priorities of interaction. Particular emphasis was placed on strengthening of the trust-based political interaction, which is consonant with the principles of the International Year of Peace and Trust proclaimed on the initiative of President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov.

During the meeting, Turkmenistan’s position was also avowed on ensuring of the energy, transport and ecological security at the regional and international level, including in the transport-transit communication sector. In this context, it was noted that in the years ahead our country intends to promote the transport interrelationship and steadiness of trade relations, through in-full unleashing of the untapped transport-transit potential of Central Asia in particular.

By the outcomes of meeting, a number of documents were approved.

FORUMS

International forum on attracting investments into the oil/gas sector of Turkmenistan

The Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Turkmenistan hosted the International forum on attracting investments into the oil/gas sector of Turkmenistan, which on behalf of President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov was organized by State Concerns “Türkmengaz” and “Türkmennebit”, the State Corporation “Türkmengeologiýa”, and the Ministry of Finance and Economy of the country.

The forum was attended by representatives of the government structures, core ministries and departments, leading oil/gas, service and consulting companies, reputable international organizations and financial structures, diplomatic and scientific circles as well as mass media.

The fact that around 500 delegates, more than 200 big companies from dozens of countries of the world have been registered in the forum (a record-high event by the number and geography of its participants) testifies to Turkmenistan's high investment attractiveness for the foreign business circles.

The plenary session was dedicated to the global trends in the energy markets and investment capacities of Turkmenistan, which is reckoned among the world energy powers.

It was highlighted in the reports that according to the priorities of the policy pursued by President Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov, Turkmenistan, over the last ten years, makes significant investments (both government and private) into the production sphere to make a solid foundation for steadfast development and diversification of the national economy. The biggest investments are thereto made in the oil/gas sector.

Executive Secretary of the UN Economic and Social Commission for Asia and Pacific (ESCAP) Armida Salsiah Alisjahbana, General Secretary of the International Energy Forum (IEF) Joseph McMonigle, Acting Permanent Coordinator of the UN in Turkmenistan Christine Weigand, Trade Envoy of the Prime Minister of Great Britain in Turkmenistan Baroness Nicolson Winterborn, head of the State Oil Company of the Azerbaijan Republic Rovnag Abdullayev, and others have taken part in discussion (including in the online format) of the current condition and forecasts for the global energy further development.

Special focus in the reports has been made on the necessity of restoration of the world economy in the post-pandemic period and transfer to the eco-friendly development with a glance to the global

warming, which is today a serious challenge for the humankind.

According to the forecasts, the demand for energy carriers will grow together with the world economy and population. The natural gas will thereto be one of the most demand-driven hydrocarbon resources, being a cost- and energy-efficient eco-friendly kind of fuel.

As is known, taking the first place in Central Asia and fourth place in the world by the natural gas reserves, our country is reckoned among the Eurasia's biggest producers of eco-friendly fuel and a serious exporter of it to the PRC.

The Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the People's Republic of China to Turkmenistan Qian Naicheng has highlighted that cooperation between China and Turkmenistan in the gas sphere is a bright demonstration of the mutuality-based bilateral relations.

“The Chinese side is ready to take advantage of the opportunities for comprehensive expansion of cooperation and attaching to it a new life energy”, - Qian Naicheng said.

The work of Forum was continued by the session “Role of financial institutions in maintaining of the global energy agenda”, which was centered on such issues, as the COVID-19 influence on investments, achievement of the goals of the Paris Climate Treaty by oil and gas companies, the latest trends in funding the oil/gas projects.

Special interest the participants of the forum have evinced in the reports presented at the panel session “Offshore fields of the Caspian Sea: Practice of development and investment opportunities”. In particular, foreign companies working in our country have made presentations of their activity.

In the frames of the session “Investment projects in monetization of hydrocarbons – an insight into the future”, detailed information about the activity for diversification of the oil/gas industry of Turkmenistan, opening of new facilities for deep processing of oil and natural gas has been presented.

Thus, Turkmenistan will not only strengthen its positions in the world energy market as a big supplier of energy carriers. The country's oil/gas sector will become modern, high-technological, efficient, steady-developing complex, which is based on the natural-resource and scientific-technical potential of the country, world achievements in this sphere.

In the frames of the International Forum, a number of contracts with foreign companies, including the procurement of big shipments of hydrofined diesel fuel, jet kerosene, calcined petroleum coke, and other production of the Turkmenbashy Refinery Complex, have been signed.

At the online meetings between the heads of structural divisions of the FEC, financial-

economic complex of Turkmenistan and their potential partners, consideration was given to the perspective directions of interaction and implementation of concrete projects.

ECONOMY

Turkmenistan – Azerbaijan: advancing maritime transport communication

The Turkmenbashi International Seaport welcomed the arrival of “Azerbaijan” Ferry – a new vessel, which has made its first working ‘voyage’ to Turkmenistan. Being built in 2020 at the Baku Shipyard to order of the “Azerbaijani Caspian Lines” Close Corporation, the modern ferry is designated for transportation of passengers, railroad and motor transport vehicles.

The 154-meter long, 5.54 thousand tons load-carrying capacity ferry has delivered modern equipment to our country.

Due to modernization and technical rearmament of the country’s main sea gates, the volumes of annual cargo transport by sea as well as the number of foreign ships entering the Turkmen harbor grow steadily. A corollary of it is the arrival of “Azerbaijan” Ferry, which started its labor biography from transportation of the cargo to the Turkmen seaport.

CULTURAL HERITAGE

International forum dedicated to Sultan Sanjar

The State Institute of Culture hosted an international meeting «The historical image of Sultan Sanjar, the principles of peacefulness and friendliness inherent to the mentality of the Turkmen people», which was held in the mixed format.

The forum, organized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Education, and the Academy of Sciences of Turkmenistan, was attended (in the online format including) by

Turkmen scientists and specialists, as well as their colleagues from dozens of countries of the world. Among them are the heads and representatives of large scientific centers, museums and universities in Japan, Saudi Arabia, Romania, USA, Great Britain, Italy, Kazakhstan, Iraq, Algeria, Afghanistan, Tajikistan, etc.

Those speaking during the meeting have underlined the role of the present international forum in the study and preservation of the spiritual heritage of the mankind. The Turkmen people’s great ancestors had created the largest libraries and scientific centers, opened observatories, and encouraged the development of arts.

This all was covered in the reports: «The peacemaking initiatives of President of Turkmenistan Gurbanguly Berdymuhamedov - the spiritual heritage of Sultan Sanjar», «Representation of the ideas of peace and trust in the Seljuk history», «The principles of peacefulness and humanism of Seljuk sultans.»

The scientists have presented interesting archaeological and manuscript information about the history, economy and culture, literature, scientific institutions and libraries of the Great Seljuk period.

Separate reports were devoted to the peculiarities of the cultural life in Central Asia in the Sultan Sanjar epoch, to the contribution of the Seljuk rulers to world culture and history.

COMMODITIES EXCHANGE NEWS

At the past week’s trades at the State Commodities and Raw Materials Exchange of Turkmenistan, 7 transactions were registered.

The deals in the foreign currency for purchasing of the cotton yarn, one-color and jacquard terry items were made by the entrepreneurs from Turkey and Azerbaijan. The sum total of contracts was over US \$1,149 thousand.

The in-manat deals were made for purchasing of cotton yarn. Among the buyer-countries there were the United Arab Emirates, Turkey. The sum total of the deals exceeded 7,725 thousand manats.
